The Bursary will be awarded to a student who might otherwise struggle to find the necessary funding to pursue their chosen career.</p>
 <p>Teesside Power Fund Educational Bursary</p>	£4,500 (over 3 years)	The nine wards in the vicinity of the Teesside Power Station at Wilton	<p>The Teesside Power Fund Educational Bursary supports students who live in Eston, Dormanstown, Kirkleatham, Teesville, Newcomen, Coatham, Grangetown, South Bank or Normanby and who are intending to study for a degree at university in disciplines relevant to energy generation. Courses, which qualify for this Bursary Scheme, will incorporate some elements of engineering, chemistry, physics and mathematics.</p> <p>The successful candidate for the bursary will be expected to obtain good higher level qualifications e.g. 'A' level or other appropriate BTEC qualifications and will be from a background of modest means. The Bursary will be awarded to a student who might otherwise struggle to find the necessary funding to pursue their chosen career.</p>
 <p>The Hill Bursary</p>	£4,500 (over 3 years)	Tees Valley and its immediate neighbourhood	<p>This Educational Bursary supports students intending to study Business, Economics or Accounts at a UK University starting in the autumn of 2011. Decisions will be made on 'A' Level grades or equivalent achieved and personal circumstances. Bursaries will be awarded to successful applicants who might otherwise struggle to find the necessary funding to pursue their chosen career.</p>
 <p>Pursuit of Excellence</p>	£1,000	Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland, Stockton-on-Tees	<p>The Pursuit of Excellence Scheme helps young people (aged 8-24) who are excelling in their chosen speciality and who are in need of financial assistance to achieve their aims. The Foundation looks for those who are likely to reach national and international prominence in a sporting or artistic endeavour.</p> <p><b>Note: you can only make one successful application in any 12 month period. You can apply again in future years, leading to a maximum of £5,000 during the lifetime of the programme.</b></p>
 <p>Teesside Emergency Relief Fund</p>	Small grants – no maximum	Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar & Cleveland, Stockton-on-Tees	<p>Teesside Emergency Relief Fund (TERF) provides financial assistance to address a specific need or to reduce or relieve some specific hardship or distress e.g. social or medical.</p>
